

Installation Instructions for Windows 3.1

1. Place your Walden Font Disk into your computer's disk drive
2. Open the Windows Control Panel
3. Double-Click on "Fonts"
4. Choose "Install New Font" and specify your disk drive as the source.
5. Windows will display "Kurrent Kupferstich" in the Font list box.
6. Select the font and choose "Add". Make sure "Copy to Windows System Directory" is checked.
7. The Font is now installed. Restart your system to use the font in any Windows Program.

Installation Instructions for Windows 95

1. Place your Walden Font Disk into your Computer's disk drive
2. Click "Start" "Settings" "Control Panel"
3. Open the Fonts folder.
4. Choose "File" "Install New Font"
5. Windows will display "Kurrent Kupferstich" in the Font list box.
6. Select the font and choose "Add". Make sure "Copy to Windows System Directory" is checked.
7. The Font is now installed. Restart your system to use the font in any Windows Program.

Using Kurrent Kupferstich.

Kurrent Kupferstich makes extensive use of special characters to improve its appearance on paper. We found it most practicable to type the desired text first in any regular font, then change the font to *Kurrent Kupferstich*. Change or insert special Characters where applicable to improve the appearance of your text. You can use the Find/ Replace command in your word processing software to make most of the corrections. English or other foreign words occurring in a German text should be written in a latin script font.

Special Characters

The following is a list of special characters. Some are assigned to certain keys, others require the use of the ASCII code system. To generate a letter, hold down the ALT-key on your keyboard and key in the four-digit code using the number pad (make sure NUMLOCK is switched on) Thus ALT + 0252 results in "ü." The ending-s is used at the end of syllables and whole words. The use of double-m and double-n characters is optional. The free joint can be used to improve the spacing between characters where necessary. *Kurrent Kupferstich* looks best when printed in sizes above 50 points.


