How to use your new font

To install your new TrueType Font for MS-Windows, follow these easy steps:

- 1. Start MS-Windows and infert the Diskette into your disk drive.
- 2. Open the Control Panel in the Program Manager
- 3. Click on the Fonts icon and choose Add.
- 4. Locate the Drives lift. Click on it once and chose the drive that holds the diskette (usually a: or b:)
- 5. The font window will now difplay Old State House (True Type)
- 6. Make fure that the box Copy Fonts to Windows Directory if checked.
- 7. Select the font by highlighting it and click OK.
- 8. Reftart MS-Windows
